

Monitoring Report

Sept 25, 2014



Eight lake association people went out on the lake the morning of Sept. 25 and raked up samples of vegetation to see if the lake added any new (especially unwanted new) plant types. We did not find any thing that caused concerns. We think that we are still free of Eurasian Water Milfoil. Of course we can never be sure, so we need each of you to help. If you are on the lake look on the shore and into the water to see if you find a thick concentration of bright green plants that seem to grow from the bottom to near the surface. If you see some, get some of it and take it home. Call someone that you know is a boat inspector, or take it to the DNR to have them confirm if it is EWM, or not. We need to be vigilant **all year. Everyone that lives on, or loves, Crescent Lake should educate him or herself about how to identify EWM and how to respond to ANY suspicious new plants.**
